

To the Shallowford Community,

We wanted to inform you that a person who was on Shallowford's campus on January 11 and 13, 2021, has tested positive for SARS-CoV-2, the novel coronavirus that causes COVID-19. This individual is in good condition and is quarantined. We are praying for that person, and we are grateful for our community's fast response in order to protect others. This is a general community update, not a close contact notification.

In order to help keep our community safe, we are taking the following steps:

- Everyone who may have been exposed to the person who tested positive has been notified, advised to quarantine, and asked not to return to Shallowford's campus for 14 days.
- Because we are a community who cares for each other, we have made it known that the church is available to support people during their quarantine as needed.
- The Shallowford sanctuary will be closed completely for one day for deep cleaning.

We invite you to join us in praying for all people who are affected by the COVID-19 pandemic, for frontline workers, and for our healthcare system. May our community continue to be a beacon of hope in the city, reflecting the light and love of Christ!
