2016

Shalom International Ministries – salary support for the organizing pastor to transition from part-time to full-time ministry to support the growth and flourishing of the new church development

Grant: \$12,000/year for 5 years

2017

New American Pathways – funding for Shallowford to help resettle a refugee family

Grant: \$3,000

2018

I Care Atlanta for Resume Café Program – support social work intern to establish a resume writing program at I Care Atlanta to support underprivileged job seekers

Grant: \$5,000

-LaGonave Haiti Partnership – demolition and recreation of the preschool playground at St. Francis School

Grant: \$5,200

2019

Zo Presbyterian Church – partial scholarships for 16 children and youth from this New Worshipping Community of Zo refugees to attend SPC's Vacation Bible School

Grant: \$480

Memorial Drive Ministries – convert old Choir Room to a multi-purpose children and youth space to benefit the several congregations worshipping in the sanctuary

Grant: \$15,000

Montreat Conference Center – creation of a Young Adult Experience internship in vocational discernment for camp and conference ministry

Grant: \$5,000

2020

All of SPC's **Mission Partners** who were open during the Covid-19 Pandemic – to support their ministries during this extraordinary time

Grant \$30,000

2021

Amani Women's Center – support of their Covid-19 Emergency Fund to help the refugee community in Clarkston, GA, with rent, utilities, and other urgent needs
