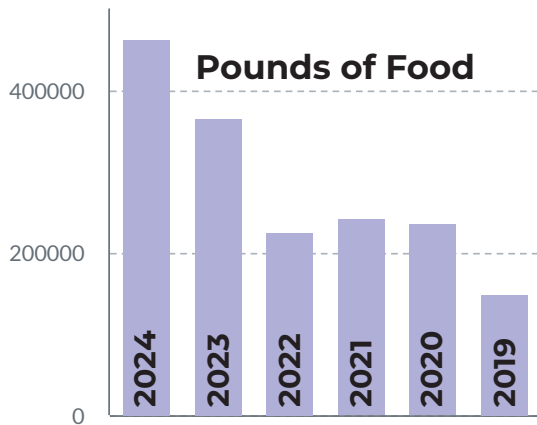

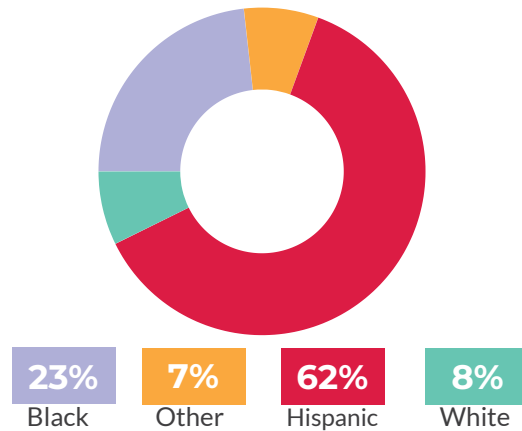
FIGHTING HUNGER

We provide food for those experiencing food insecurity through our Grocery Store-style, "client choice" pantry. Below shows the impact of food distributed in our community since 2019.

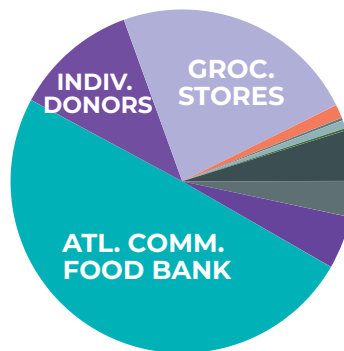

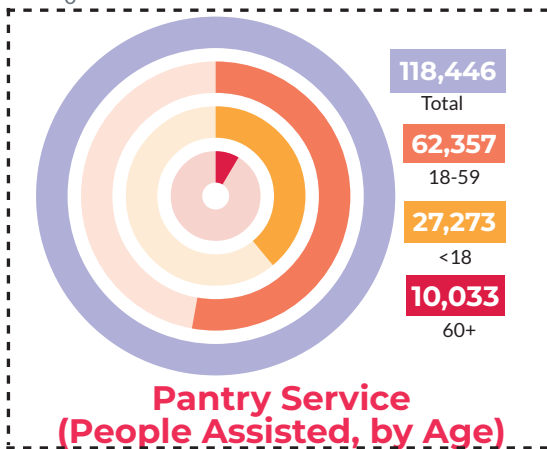

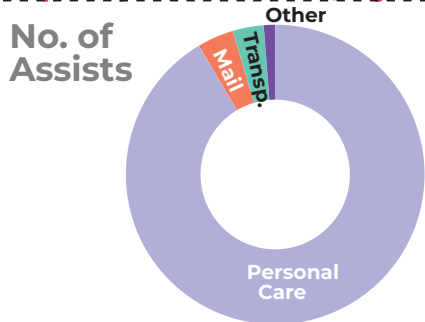

Our Financial Assistance helps families stay in warm, dry housing. Through rental and utility assistance, we help people retain their residences. For families with children already living "on the streets," we can provide short-term hotel stays. In 2024, we provided over \$122,000 in assistance.
